What: National Day of Mourning to lament the tragic deaths of women and babies whose lives have been taken by abortion

Why: Consistently across the country the black community has suffered the greatest harm as the abortion industry pushes its program of population control by abortion, as Supreme Court Justice Ruth Bader Ginsburg notified the nation would happen because Roe was the case that was going to enable us "to get rid of the populations we don't want too many of". The battle for civil rights in America did not end with the passage of the 1964 Civil Rights Act, nor did the racism that defined many American institutions. Only the battleground changed and the fight has moved into the corridors of the abortion industry.
