Press Release: Tens of Thousands of U.S. Teen Abortions Illegal

Miss "F.B." won her law suit claim of being put at increased BC (Breast Cancer) risk by a Portland, Oregon abortion clinic (All Women's Health Services) on 24 January 2005. Defendant AWHS did not dispute "F.B.'s" breast cancer claim nor any other claim, since AWHS conceded all claims via an "offer of judgment". After "F.B." launched her law suit AWHS became aware of a 1994 study by Dr. Janet Daling (who is 'prochoice') published the Journal of the National Cancer Institute; abstract URL: http://jnci.oxfordjournals.org/cgi/content/abstract/86/21/1584 One sub-group in this study were twelve with a family history of breast cancer & who had induced abortions under 18 years of age. One might expect half of those women would be in the group with BC (cases) & half to be in the control group (no history of BC). 100% of the dozen women had breast cancer & this was [medical jargon] statistically significant.

If only 20% of U.S. teenage females have a family history of beast cancer, that implies that tens of thousands of women under age 18 are having illegal abortions performed on them every year. Increasing a teen's breast cancer risk via an elective (i.e. unnecessary) surgery is gross medical negligence. All seven abortion consent forms Brent Rooney has seen make zero mention of elevated BC risk for women under 18 age with a family history of breast cancer.

Can abortion-quackery be virtually eliminated? The two (2) major side-effect risks of abortion are BREAST CANCER and future premature & handicapped newborns (e.g.s. Cerebral Palsy, Mental Retardation, Autism).
