A quote from Sanger said, "sterilizing those designated unfit" would benefit society. Nazi Germany adopted eugenics as the main platform for the extermination of Jews, gypsies, mentally challenged, disabled or anyone else not fitting the Aryan master profile.

Mercury reporter Joe Rodriguez ignored the most glaring statistic of blacks showing practically no growth compared to other racial groups. While every ethnic group enjoyed robust growth of at least 50%, the best statistic on black growth was a pitiful 3.2% increase in San Jose.

It's been six months since this damning fact came out with no adequate analysis from anyone. The silence is telling enough.

So why is the black population flat-lining or going down in nearly every area? Oakland is down 23%, San Francisco is down 19%, Milpitas is down 14%, and the "radical" black genocide website seems to be the only

source speaking out against the poor showing in black growth statistics.

National Columnist Star Parker wrote one opinion on abortion being the ruining of the black community and now statistics appear to be backing her up.
