#### ISSUES4LIFE FOUNDATION: Speak Up Now Or Forever Hold Your Peace!

Union City, CA (ISSUES4LIFE FOUNDATION) Monday, July 12th, 2009 – According to the New York Times, sitting U.S. Supreme Court Justice Ruth Bader Ginsburg had this to say about her thoughts regarding Roe vs. Wade:

**“Frankly I had thought that at the time Roe was decided, there was concern about population growth and particularly growth in populations that we don’t want to have too many of.”**

#### Like former U.S. Supreme Court Justice Oliver Wendell Holmes ...

**Who** in 1927 wrote: "It is better for all the world, if instead of waiting to execute degenerate offspring for crime, or to let them starve for their imbecility, society can prevent those who are manifestly unfit from continuing their kind ... Three generations of imbeciles are enough."

It is important to note here that this view mirrored the views of **President Theodore Roosevelt**, who originally appointed Holmes to the Supreme Court and wrote in a January 3rd, 1913 letter to **Charles Davenport**, Founder of the American Eugenics Society:

"... society has no business to permit degenerates to reproduce their kind."

#### Like the Founding Member of the American Eugenics Society Frederick Osborn ...

**Who** in 1973 wrote "Birth Control and abortion are turning out to be the great eugenic advances of our time."

**Sitting U. S. Supreme Court Justice Ruth Bader Ginsburg** also felt government sanctioned and taxpayer funded abortion (i.e., prenatal murder) was appropriate as a "population control" measure.

As an African-American and a man of the cloth I am offended by her comments and at the same time I am outraged at the tacit consent in the form of the deafening silence coming from the African-American pulpit.

In the past, during wedding ceremonies, many of us used to say: "**If anyone has any reason why these two people should not be married, speak up now or forever hold your peace.**" Today this phrase is so rarely used that it is almost obsolete.

However, given the apparent marriage between the eugenically obsessed mindset of financially and racially motivated **U. S. power brokers** and the sinful suicidal silence in the African-American pulpit regarding the **impact of abortion in the Black community**, I believe it is time to revive this old phrase.
