Issues4Life Foundation – “Nobody Has A Right To Do A Wrong!”

Union City, CA (**ISSUES4LIFE FOUNDATION**) September 15th, 2008 – Walter Hoyer, CEO and President of the **Issues4Life Foundation** says: “Nobody has a right to do a wrong!”

Mr. Hoyer continues by saying: “Nancy Pelosi’s comments regarding the doctrines of the Catholic Church [1] as they relate to when a baby gets human rights, reflect the struggle pro-choice proponents have defining human life in the womb.

When Abraham Lincoln debated Stephen Douglas regarding the issue of slavery in the United States, he exposed the faulty logic used by the pro-choice community today.
